2023 CREDIT UNION SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM**

The Cooperative Credit Union Association, Inc.'s Credit Union Scholarship Program will be awarding six \$1,500 college scholarships in 2023. Information regarding eligibility for this scholarship is listed below:

- Eligibility is limited to high school seniors who will be enrolled in an undergraduate college/university degree program during the 2023-2024 academic year.
- Applicant or parent/guardian must be a member of TFCU or must become a member.
- The applicant must complete the scholarship application form that is attached. Applications must be submitted to TFCU on or before **March 31, 2023**.
- TFCU will select the top 3 applications and forward them to the Cooperative Credit Union Association, Inc. for final consideration. Winners will be selected in Spring 2023.


Students must submit the following items with their completed applications. All items requested must be received in order for the application to qualify for consideration:

- Students must submit a typewritten essay of at least 250 words describing what career you wish to pursue when you complete your education and why.
- An academic transcript of grades
- A detailed list of extracurricular/community and/or volunteer activities.
