Use your Debit Card to make everyday purchases and TFCU will round up the change on the transaction to the nearest whole dollar. The difference will automatically transfer from your Checking Account to your Savings or Club account at the end of each business day!

Here's how the Debit Card Round-Up Program works:

Debit Card Roundup transfers are eligible for Debit Card purchases only. Transfers will occur on the same day the transaction is posted to your Checking Account. Once enrolled, transfers will begin to post on the next business day. Purchases made on weekends or holidays will post on the next business day. If on a business day you do not have sufficient available funds in your Checking Account, or if any transaction has overdrawn your Checking Account, TFCU will not round up purchases posted on that business day and will cancel the transfer for that day. If your Debit Card purchase is subsequently cancelled or reversed, the Debit Card Roundup transfer remains in the savings account. Not available on Business Accounts or IRAs. Membership is established by opening a \$5 share/savings account and is available to anyone who lives, works, worships or attends school in Bristol County, Massachusetts; Bristol, Kent, Newport and Providence counties in Rhode Island; and the Rhode Island towns of Charlestown, Exeter, Hopkinton, Narragansett, New Shoreham, North Kingstown, Richmond and South Kingstown.
